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1. Introduction

TCC VET is an Erasmus+ project devoted to enhance the teaching & learning methods in VET schools around Europe, empowering teachers with modern digital skills. This will be done by collecting and testing innovative e-learning tools, starting from the countries where the partners are located:

- TURKEY, Elazig: Elazığ Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi (project leader, vocational training centre of secondary level)
- GREECE, Piraeus: Idec - Aintek Symvouloi Epicheiriseon Efarmoges Ypsilis Technologias Ekpaidefsi Anonymi Etaireia (project partner, training consulting company)
- SPAIN, Badajoz: Eolas (project partner, consulting company)
- ITALY, Milan: Dlearn - European Digital Learning Network (project partner, association of organizations in the field of education)
- NETHERLANDS, Leeuwarden: Stichting Incubator (project partner, foundation involved in training activities)

Vocational education in Europe is facing quite everywhere problems due to the low-level usage of digital educational tools. While the student who enters a VET institute spends and lives his life in the digital age, the scholar system is not ready to follow this momentum. In many European Countries the digital reform of the education system started yet, and most of the schools are now equipped with digital hardware they can use in the everyday classroom work, but the average teachers' training has not followed the development of the requirements of today's world.

Of course, the role of teachers is vital in the learning process of students. However, in true spirit of Lifelong Learning, their teaching role and their required competences need further improvement to be able to maintain high quality education, especially now in a digital era. Recent research in the European Commission's initiated 'Open Education Europa' platform shows that 70% of VET teachers recognize the importance of digital-supported teaching and learning, but 6 out of 10 tell they didn't receive any training on how to use ICT in the classroom.

As a result, only 1 in 4 students believes he's taught by digitally confident and supportive teachers, and we know that the quality of teaching has a direct effect upon learner's attainment. In this context, teachers, educators, school directors and teacher's trainers are called on to play a key role in modernising education. To do that, they need to develop their own knowledge and skills. Using more digital tools in their lessons, teachers and educators can find opportunities to develop their teaching techniques and to increase teachers' development and quality.

2. TCC VET specific aim

It is quite easy to guess that the final goal of this project, like many others do, is to facilitate the path of VET students towards a better employability in the labour market once finished their training period.

Boundaries are hopefully disappearing in Europe, more and more jobs are becoming international and less dependent on the Country that you live in. Students are therefore also being stimulated to travel more internationally and take internships or studies abroad. In such a situation, it's clear that developing the 21st Century digital skills for VET teachers and students will help the EU as a whole to become more competitive: students will have better career opportunities and EU businesses will gain more highly qualified students.

The pandemic Covid-19, occurred in 2020 all over the world, contributed giving evidence to the relevance of a higher degree of integration of digital skills in education. Therefore, TCC VET will help supporting teachers and trainers involved in VET education in updating and modernising school curricula, to match the rapid evolution of technical innovation. Improving the teaching skills of VET educators, and teachers in general, can hardly help this process, and this is the reason why TCC VET aims to contribute directly to the professional development of VET teachers, supplying them with a TEACHER TOOLBOX including 17 digital and interactive tools selected as the most useful to improve their lessons by using modern technologies.

3. Target group

The teachers are the true target group of this project, because they are the genuine “power unit” of any school and they transfer their knowledge to the ultimate beneficiaries, the students. They need to be always updated, ready to explore the opportunities the digital tools can bring and able to use them in the teaching&learning process. Mostly in vocational schools, where students attend their courses hopefully to enter directly in the labour market, without any further step, the above mentioned investment in hardware stuff will be ineffective if teachers cannot optimally use the facilities in their teaching. Therefore, TCC VET will take an integrated approach to serve the needs of teachers and their VET institutes, to optimally engage the final beneficiaries, the students. They need an important support to become very familiar with digital skills and feel comfortable to continuously keep training when new technologies or applications arise.

4. Why apply interactive learning in class?

The answer to the title-question is very simple, almost intuitive: in this 21st Century it is no more possible to apply the traditional model of teaching & learning, because

the world outside the schools is not the same as some decades ago, and mainly vocational students need a different approach abreast of the times. For better or worse, the relations model with teachers changed too, the gap closed, and interaction is a fact.

Nevertheless, revolutionising existing curricula in vocational schools overnight is not a realistic goal, nor a good idea, for several practical and policy reasons. It's a process requiring its physiological terms, to let teachers gradually incorporate innovative ways of teaching and, fundamental, to obtain the management's commitment for the application of digital methods and tools into the existing curricula. To be effective, the strategy must involve all levels of the school organization, creating awareness and sharing around common goals from the board room to the work floor.

Considering its specific situation, each vocational school feeling ready to join TCC VET proposals will perform as a starting point an internal critical evaluation of the curricula currently in place. These curricula will be reviewed and dissected to identify the opportunities to incorporate the most suitable TCC VET elements to its organisation. Such a process will facilitate schools to turn the evaluation outcomes into action plans including proposed curricula and learning environment improvements (e.g. organization of training courses for teachers, designing of new or revised courses and teaching modules, new logistic organization of internal rooms to facilitate the use of tools with students, etc.) followed by the implementation of these action plans.

5. How to use the Toolbox in class?

Practical instructions for teachers

This Manual support teachers with precise instructions to fully understand how to use the Toolbox, giving them confidence and skills to use the selected tools in practice in the classroom, maximizing the results in terms of students' engagement. Applying interactive learning in class corresponds in fact to leap on the overall shared theory expressed in several pedagogical studies over the past 10-15 years: the effective engagement of students, making their learning process interesting, challenging and useful, can be obtained only if teachers are ready to make use and adequately equipped with digital competences, because we live in a digital era continuously asking us to improve our skills to be able to function properly in today's world.

Lessons offering the typical contents of the different topics of study are always important, that's sure, but the way to teach them should change, because world is changing, students are changing, and their learning requires new rules to be effective: nowadays students need different skills too, the so-called 'soft skills', including doing research, working in team, problem solving, pro activeness, ICT skills, discussion, presentation, time management, etc.

In this phase, the teachers are therefore the true protagonists of the system, and through this Manual TCC VET aims at helping them to be aware of the importance to teach using digital tools, to deepen their knowledge of the Toolbox elements and to recognize from time to time what are the most suitable tools to be used in order to reach their goals with students.

The TCC VET Teacher Toolbox includes 17 tools not to be missed, with different characteristics, to be then used with students in specific contexts and to pursue specific objectives.

To facilitate the overall comprehension of the suggested tools and to make it easier to choose those matching with the current learning objectives in the class-room, 4 macro-areas were created and made available to the teachers:

- **Interactive Presentation**
- **Animation Creation**
- **Digital Collaboration & Assessment**
- **Game-based Learning**

In the next chapter, you can find practical instructions for the use of any single tool, adding to the descriptions accompanying the list of tools in the Toolbox.

6. Tools per category

Anyone knows that internet is plenty of a variety of applications, involving the fields of education and communication too. Some of them are smart and useful, but some seem to be only time-waster. Discerning good and evil is not always a simple task, and the reviews from other (supposed) users risk sometimes to be fake. Besides, according to the different needs and pockets, you have to discover if an application is freeware or if there is a price to pay... So many parameters and categories should be evaluated to make a good choice, often making the task difficult and time-consuming, so that someone could also think to give up before the finish line.

Taking care of teachers and their multiple activities, TCC VET tried to do the skim for them and selected a quite small number of useful applications suitable to be used as interactive tools in the frame of the scholar activities.

Just to ease the presentation, the learning tools are grouped in 4 different categories, but of course they mix and cross elements of various kind, making each of them interesting under several points of view.

6.1. Interactive presentation tools

PowerPoint by Microsoft was the first and probably it remains the most used tool dealing with presentation in public. But in the last years several new tools came out, with very interesting functionalities to be applied to classic presentations. TCC VET selected for its VET teachers 4 tools for presentation and publication, available online for free or for a very reasonable fee.

6.1.1. CMapTools

Why using this tool – benefits

This tool is a free software that allows teachers to create cognitive maps or conceptual charts that are adapted to the needs of their creators through concepts and interconnection lines. It is therefore an interesting tool for teachers to produce summary tables on the subjects dealt with, or to establish relationships between concepts, which eases their students learning and increasing their efficiency and productivity when studying. It is an interactive and visually attractive tool that can be used as complementary material for pupils. In addition, CAMPTOOLS can also be used as a database in which to store materials that teachers consider relevant for their training, and allows them to upload their concept maps to the network.


Documents can be also saved as PDFs or images.

CAMPTOOLS allows users to share maps so they can be collaborative, identifying each one changes. It's also possible to link digital resources in them. It's necessary to download, install and execute its software on a computer, then create an account and teachers will be able to design their own schemes eventually.

The tool is being used in an educational environment, as well as for investigation and business training. This platform is available in several languages.





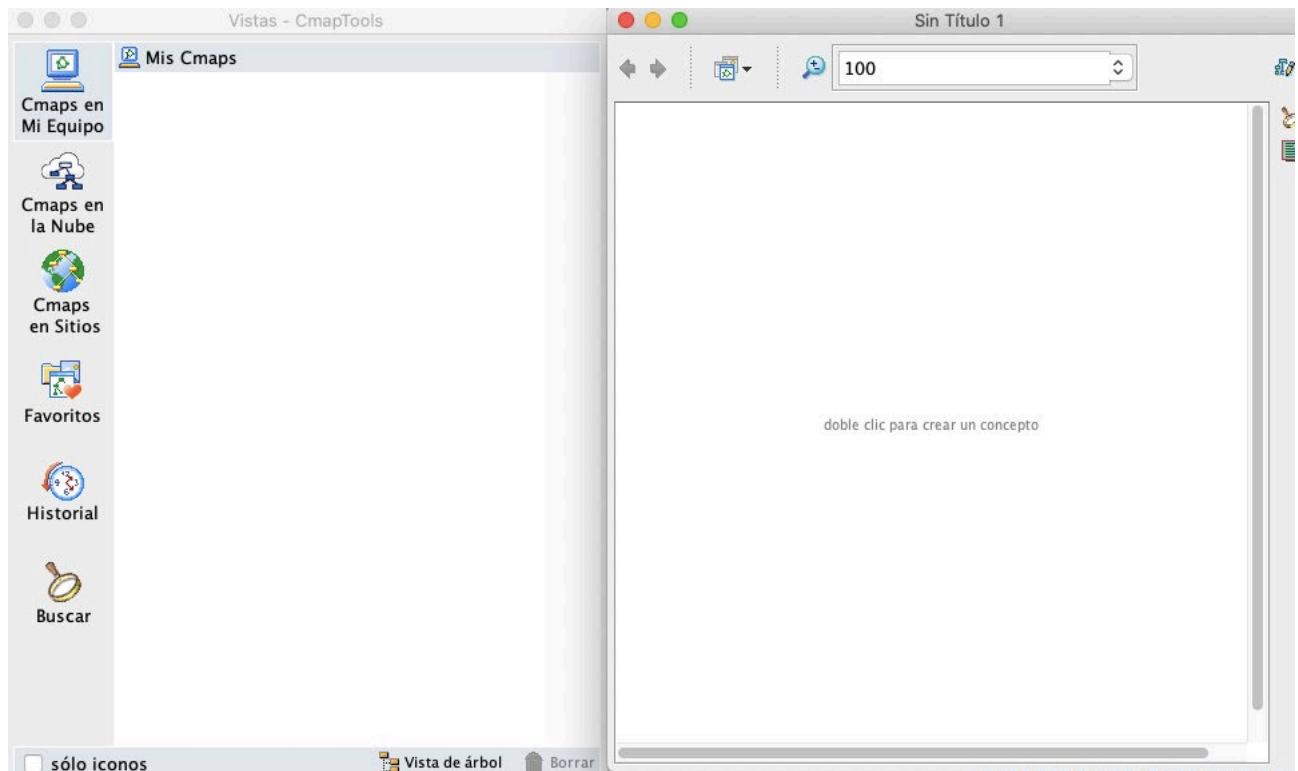

6.1.2. Flickr

Why using this tool – benefits

Flickr is probably the most well known photo sharing tool available in the web. Millions of photos are uploaded to the site on a daily basis from all around the world and of every subject you could possibly think to photograph. This incredible database of images has amazing potential for education, because it's carefully structured with specific folders, enabling teachers and students to easily find what they search for teaching and learning purposes.

The standard Flickr's edition is available for free. A professional version, with a monthly or annual fee to be paid, can be subscribed, but for educational purposes the basic option is more than enough.

Teachers and trainers normally refer to Flickr in order to enrich their presentations in classroom, independently from the subject they are busy to transfer to their students: a good presentation, including appropriate images, can encourage students to participate more actively to the lessons and to achieve new visual literacy skills they will be able to use for their own presentations. But of course there are typical applications of Flickr that make it strategic: it may happen primarily with geography lessons, when Flickr's usage allows a geotagging process that can stimulate the geographical location of the source of the photo, permitting a visual, geographical study of a particular location or place.

Flickr is an online sharing community anyone can take part to. This means that once subscribed to the website you will be able to download and use all the available imagery contents, but also to upload your pictures and videos. Of course, there are some simple rules to be respected, clearly listed in the guidelines explaining the behavioural policies, what is possible to do and what is not, also concerning the copyright laws (<https://www.flickr.com/help/guidelines>).

6.1.3.Issuu

Why using this tool – benefits


ISSUU is an online platform that allows the viewing of digital content such as documents, manuals, books, magazines, newspapers, presentations and any other type of digitized publication. Access to ISSUU requires prior registration, there are several subscription plans. It's possible to create a free account, although its options are more limited. Through ISSUU teachers have the possibility to store and visualize different teaching resources, own and from other authors, which they can share with their students through Moodle courses.

One of the main advantages of this platform is that it allows the visualization of your materials from any device, so that its interface works perfectly on mobile phones, and it is made to look as much as possible as a print publication. Another of its main utilities is that it allows you to download some of the documents available for offline reading. Some of the requested teachers point out that ISSUU was useful for them in order to compile reports and articles of a specific theme, allowing online students to get it through Moodle courses.

ISSUU has a free version for mobile (Android and Apple) and web. User can log in using Google +, LinkedIn or Facebook social network accounts.

6.1.4. Mentimeter

Why using this tool – benefits

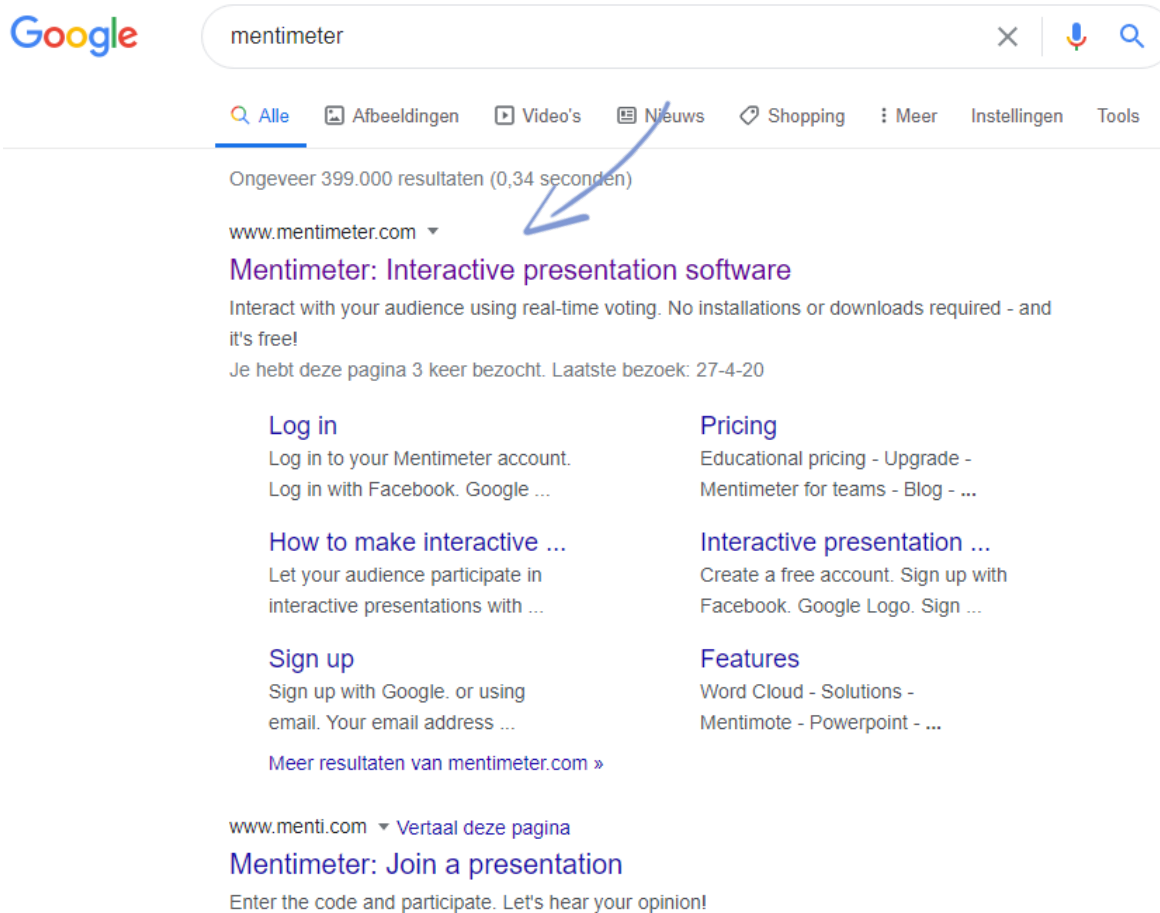
Mentimeter is a very efficient tool and can actually help simplify your life as a teacher. It brings together features from a couple of different tools and has many of the functions of a polling or quiz app. These features are simply embedded into a presentation form, so you can engage without leaving your presentation materials (you can also embed them into PowerPoint).

Mentimeter can help ensure you're receiving answers from all of your students, also the quiet ones. They don't need to speak publicly to share their ideas and opinions using the interactive features built into the application. It is a great way to engage students and help them stay focused to the topic. Instead of listening, students are asked to contribute and share opinions. They can answer your questions, submit their own, or even create their own Mentimeter presentations as part of the course. Especially the function of anonymity, allows all students to participate as they won't be exposed when the answer isn't correct. There are several ways to use Mentimeter in class; Start your class with a poll, do quick quiz to test your students, get feedback on your teaching, etc.

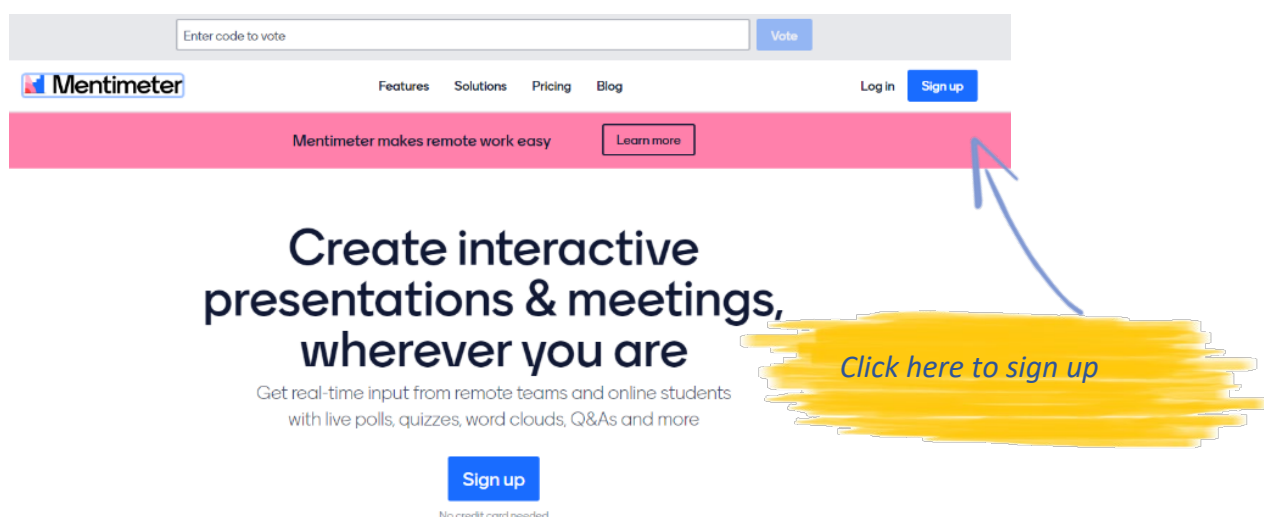

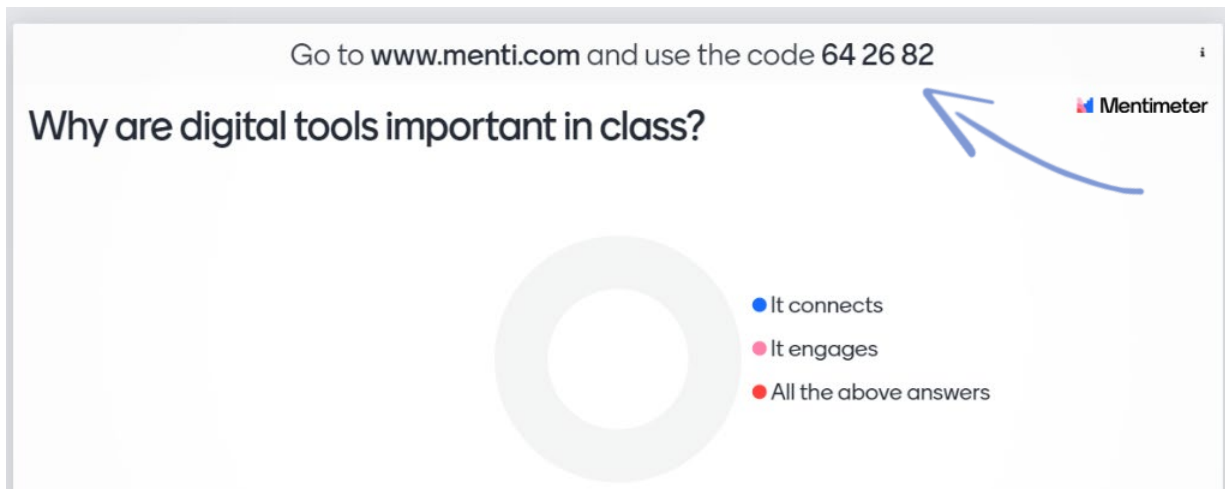

6.1.5. Prezi

Why using this tool – benefits

Prezi is a web-based tool for creating presentations (called **prezis** for short). It's similar to other presentation software like Microsoft PowerPoint, but it offers some unique features that make it a good alternative. In recent years, it has become popular in schools and businesses. If you're looking to create a presentation that's a bit more eye-catching and engaging, Prezi may be for you.

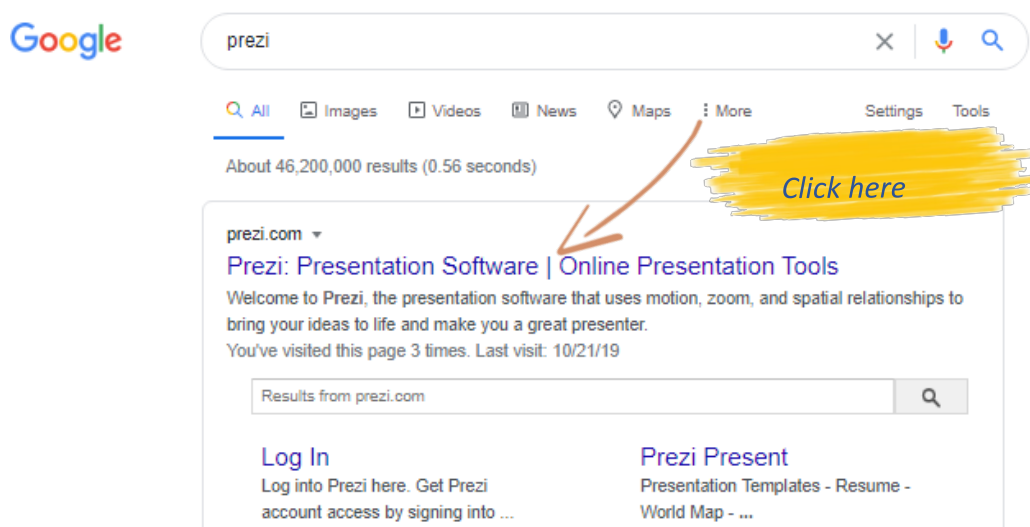
Being Prezi entirely run through your web browser, you will encounter fewer compatibility issues than with other presentation programs: your Prezi will **always look the same**, no matter what computer you're viewing it on.

Most types of presentation software use a slide-based approach, where you move back and forth between individual slides, kind of like pages in a book. Prezi, however, uses a **canvas-based approach**: instead of using slides, Prezi has one very large canvas that your presentation moves around on, zooming in and out to view various frames.

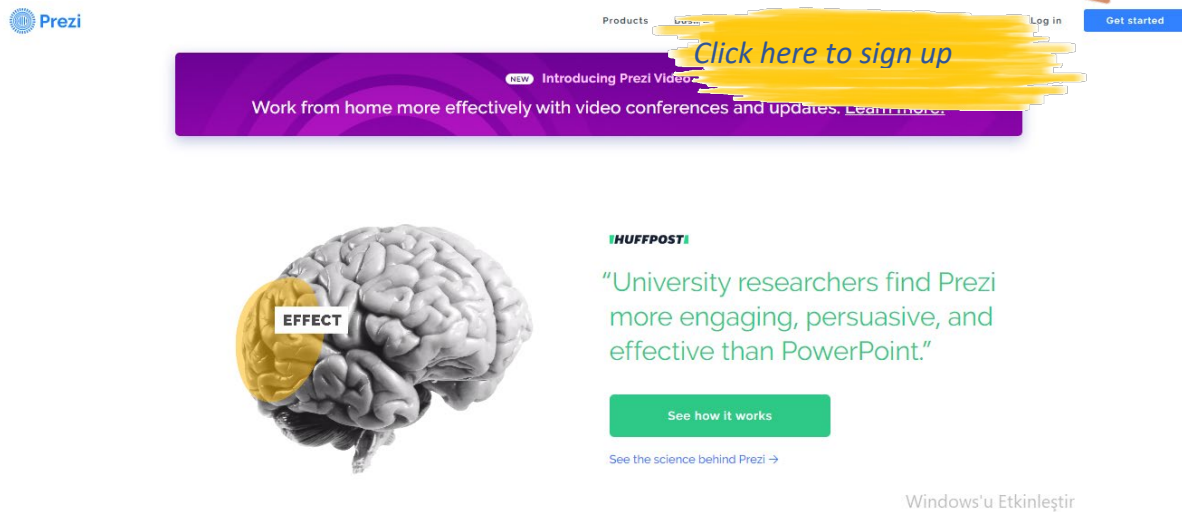

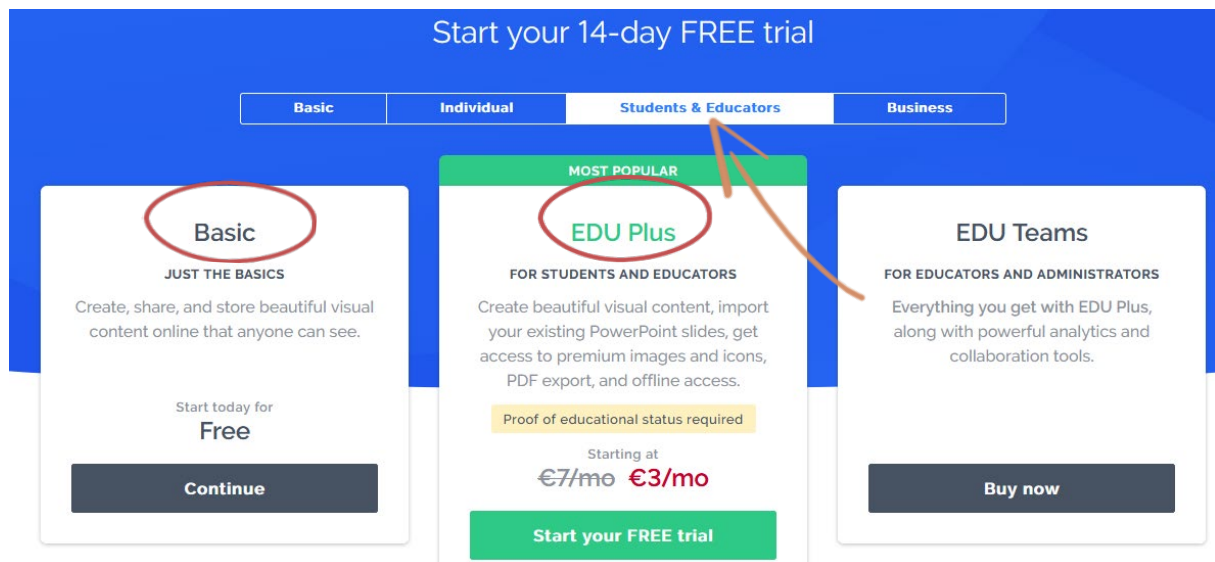


- The homepage of Prezi will appear on your screen. Now you need to sign-up to go on and so you will click “get started”:



- When you click on “get started”, then the next Prezi will appear on your screen as below, with the possibility to choose the subscription package that fits with your needs. Given that you should be interested in the “Students & Educators” package, the basic option is for free. If you prefer the EDU Plus offer, with several additional functionalities, the normal price is reduced to only €3 per month, after a 14-day free trial period.

You can start browsing your Prezi and discover it's plenty of presentation, video and design galleries, and amazing templates for your lessons, ready-to-use. But of course, you can also create your own presentations, videos and designs. Another interesting feature Prezi makes available for you is recalling your PowerPoints and transform them in Prezi presentations, just by one click. 


It is still a little bit hard to create a GIF from scratch, so the platform has a tutorial for you: <https://medium.com/@makeagif/how-to-create-a-gif-from-photos-84d7ce164322>

It is like an example, where someone from the platform is giving short description on how to make a GIF. He has collected photos of himself with VIPs and instead of a static photo album, he has developed a GIF. There are 4 basic steps to follow:

- * Select your photos by drag -drop or just uploading them,
- * select the order of their appearance,
- * choose the animation speed
- * either share it with people or download it.

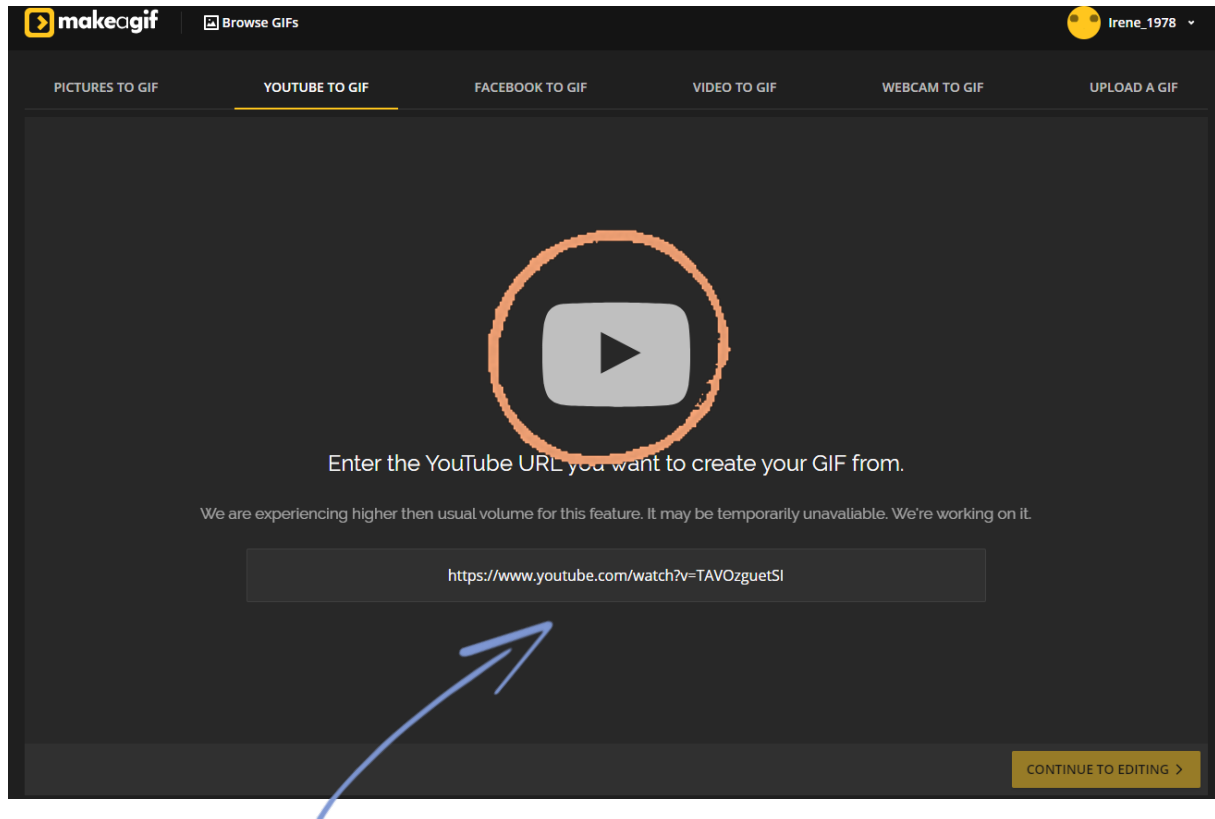

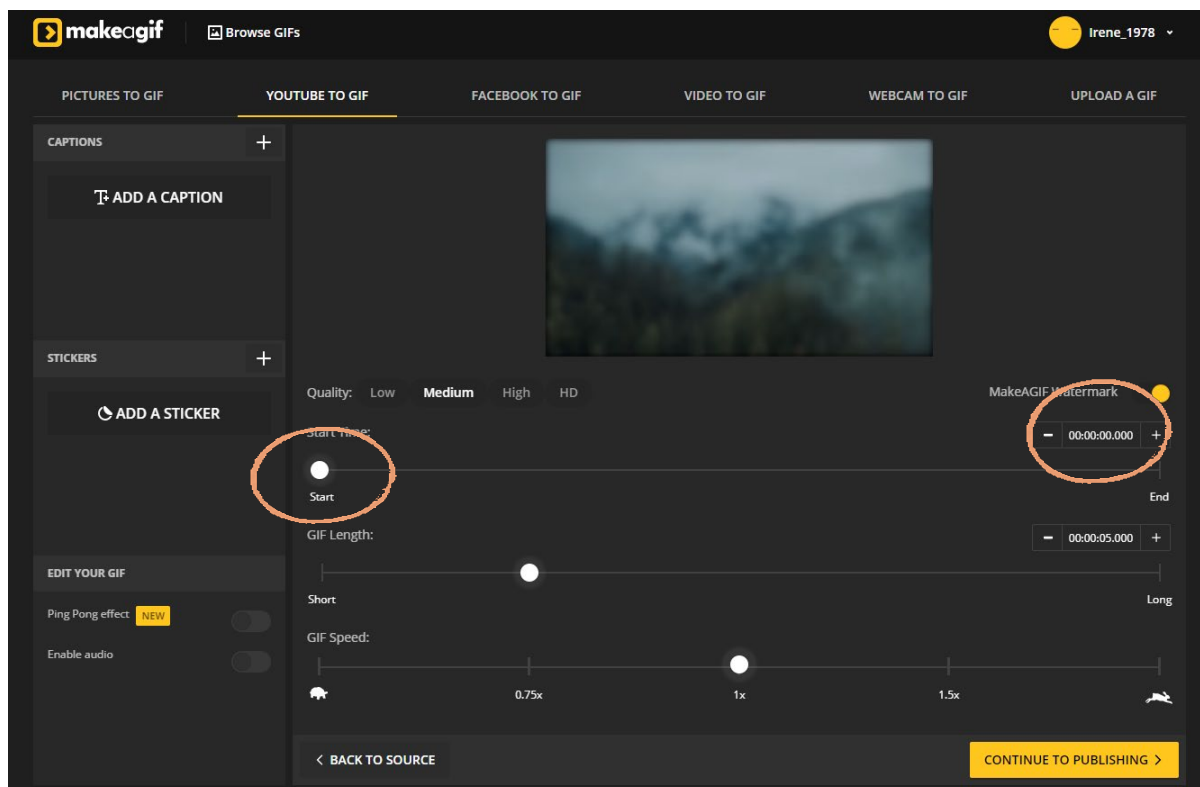

The example will be with a video with landscapes. Let's capture a few seconds from the video and create a new GIF.

First you choose a video. i.e <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TAVOzguetSI> and then try to isolate some seconds, that will eventually be the content of your GIF. In any case, it should not be too long, 4-7 seconds is ok. You track on the specific part of the video and you note down minutes and seconds. In this case we are “isolating” the part from 2nd min 33 sec until 2nd min 40 sec (02:33-02:40).



6. You enter the YouTube video's url here:
Then you click on **PLAY** and you see the whole video uploading. It takes some seconds of processing.

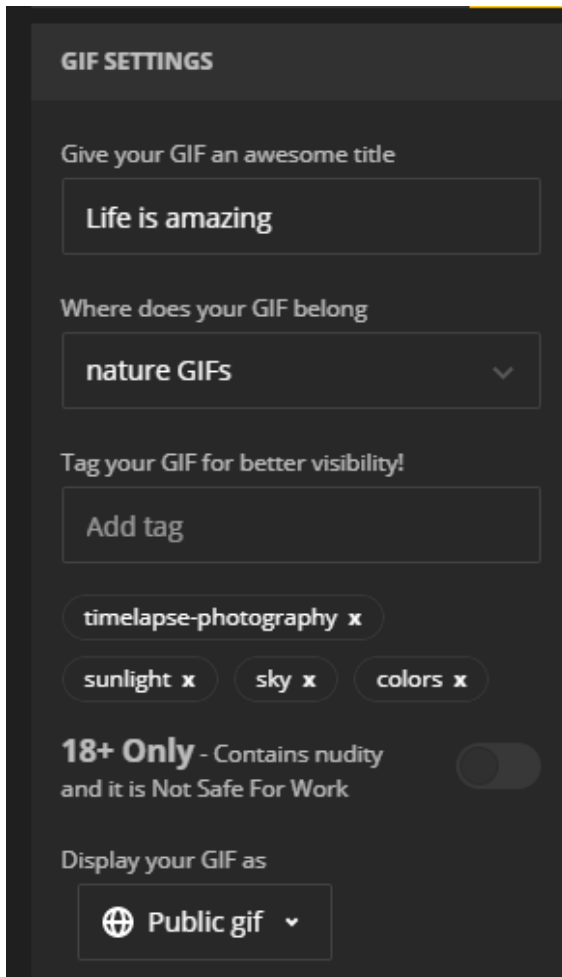


As described before, you have isolated the part already, so you go and find it on the GIF timer. You can either insert the starting second on the timer or use the bar to track it. (both on Start time). Then you decide on the GIF length, it is advisable to be not more than 7 seconds. And then, GIF speed, that means how fast your GIF will be, i.e slow motion could be a suggestion for the one you create now, because it is a timelapse, but fast GIFs are also interesting and fun, especially when cartoon characters are involved.

Next step to be CAPTION part, on the left, where you can insert a word or two. Stickers can emphasize more on your GIF.

Enable audio if you want, it surely gives another perspective.

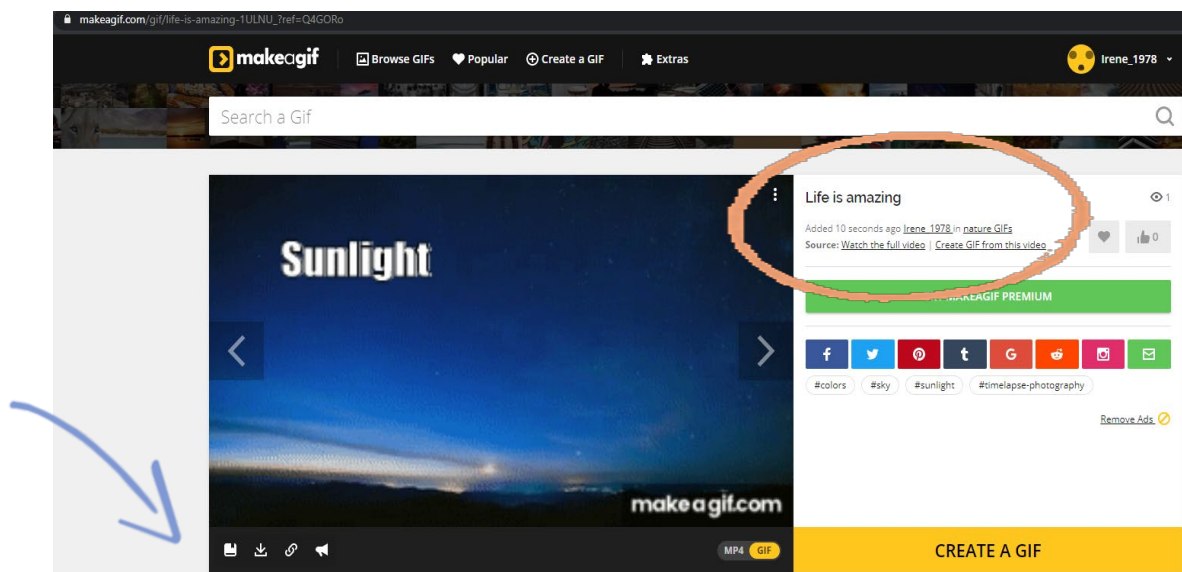

6.2.2. Powtoon

Why using this tool – benefits

The website of Powtoon tells a nice story, well describing the reason why of this tool: *In 2012, four friends met in a cafe to solve a problem: How can you communicate a message without putting your audience to sleep, or driving them to check Facebook under the table during your presentation? The answer seemed simple - how about one of those great animated videos! But working with an animation studio can take weeks and cost thousands. Our four friends decided, right then and there, to create a tool that everyone can use when they need their message to make an impact and when they can't afford to be ignored.*

What is Powtoon anyway? It's a web-based application that allows you to make presentations and videos with the help of nice animations without having to download and install anything. Its strength is to be a very intuitive and easy-to-use animation software, enabling to create nice and attractive videos without needing to be an expert. Besides, paramount add-on of Powtoon is a portfolio including specific educational solutions, enriched with ready-made templates for the classroom. The basic version of Powtoon is for free, good enough but imposing some restrictions to the users: the logo and the claim "created by Powtoon" is always fixed, at the bottom right of the screen and at the end of the video, the max length of the videos you can create is up to 3 minutes, and the max storage allowed is up to 100 MB. So, nothing of relevance, but feel free to consider professional versions too, that have nice prices for teachers and students.

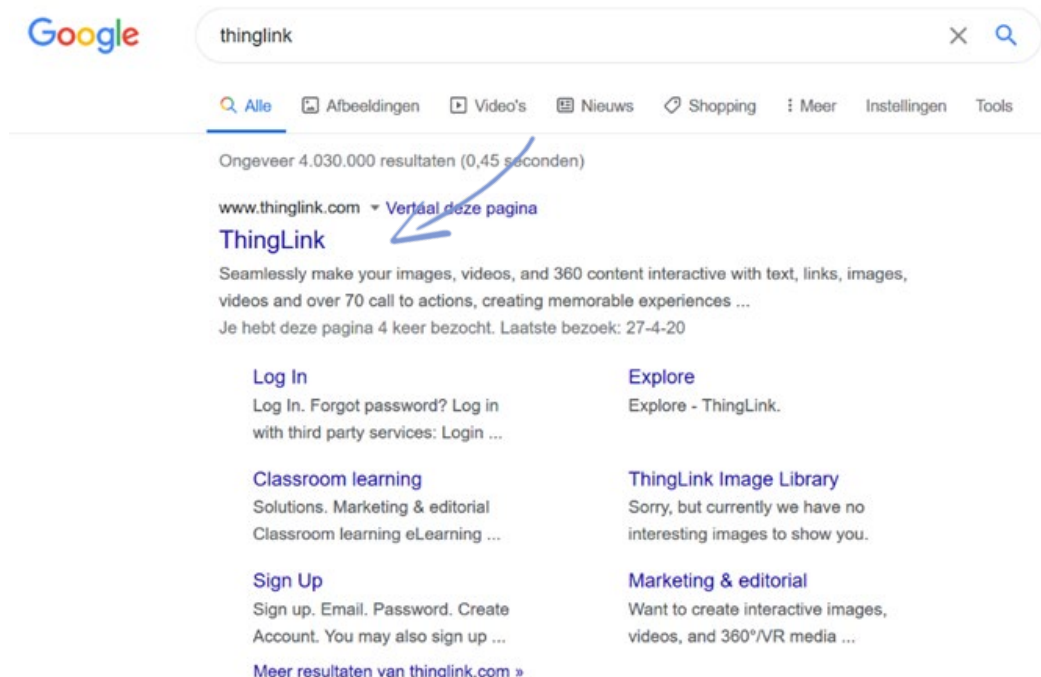
Why using this tool – benefits

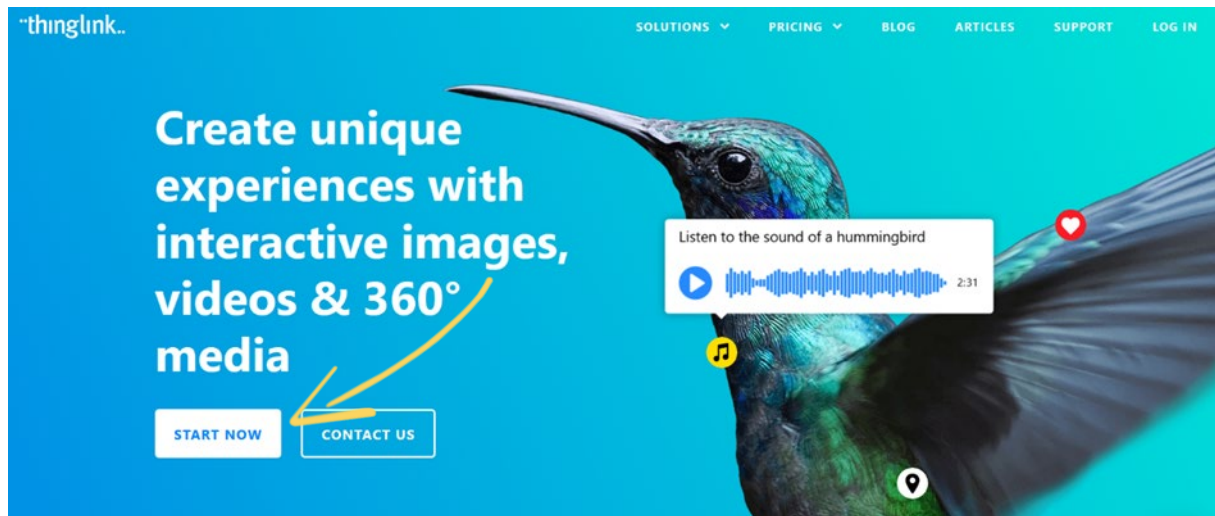

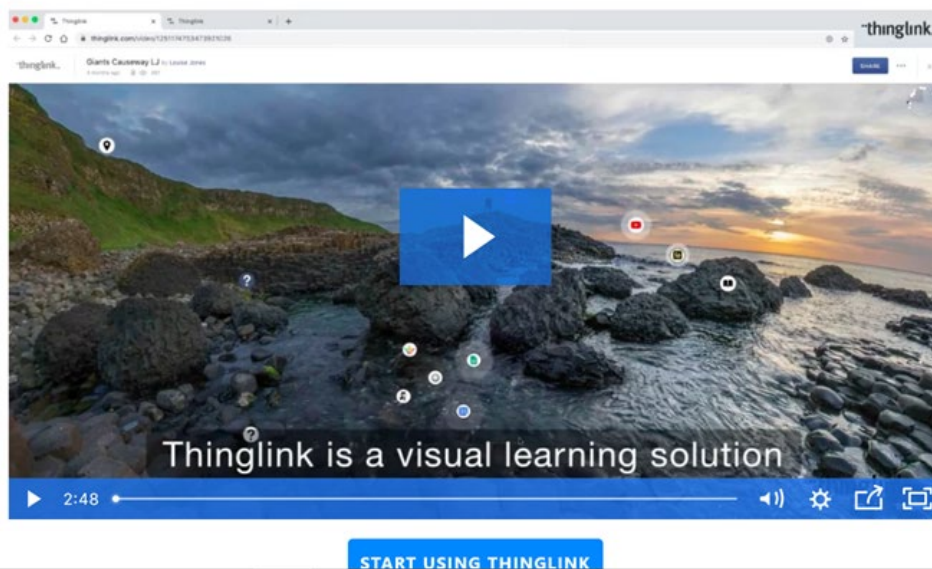

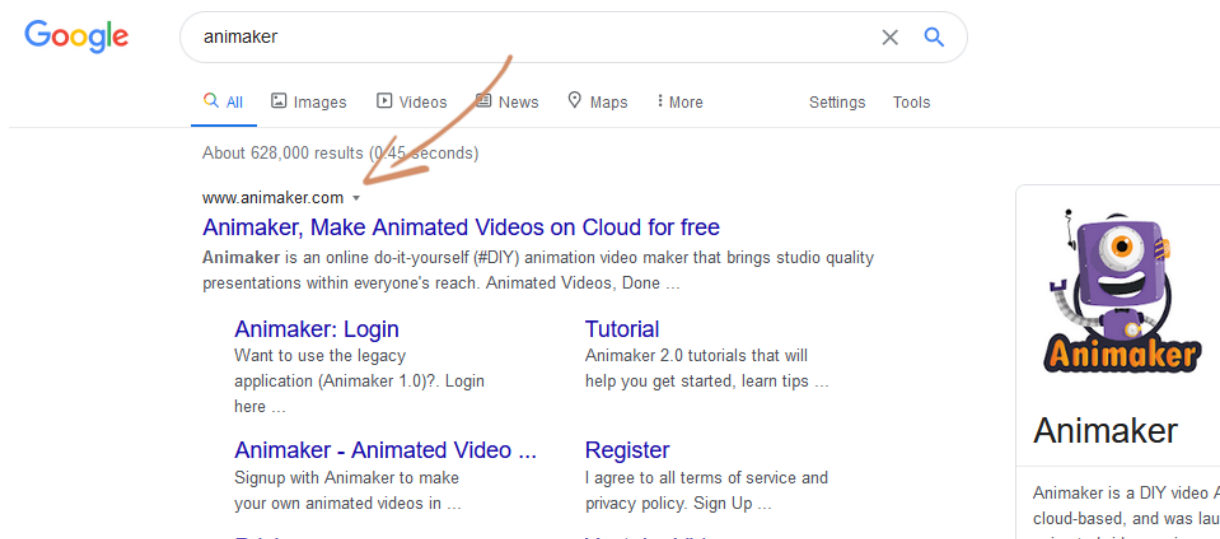
Why using this tool – benefits

6.3.1. Google Keep

Why using this tool – benefits


Google Keep is a note-taking service developed by Google. Launched in 2013, Google Keep is available on the web, and as an app for Android and iOS mobile operating systems. Keep offers a variety of features for taking notes, including text, lists, images, and audio. Users can set reminders, which are integrated with Google Now. Text from images can be extracted using optical character recognition, and voice recordings can be transcribed. The interface allows a single-column view or a multi-column one. Notes can be color-coded, and labels can be applied for organization. Later updates have added functionality to pin notes, and to collaborate on notes with other Keep users in real-time.

Using this app it will be easy to discover that it may help you in a big variety of circumstances:

- Create notes and lists, set time and place reminders, and check off your completed tasks.
- Add a collaborator to your notes and lists, then get things done together.
- Add photos and drawings, or just draw on your photos.
- Dictate your thoughts, Keep will transcribe them for you.
- Search notes by automatically created topics.
- Group notes together with appropriate labels.
- Access your notes on any device, synced automatically to your phone, tablet, watch, and laptop via the Google Keep website, or Chrome app.
- Use “Ok Google” voice commands to “take a note” or “add to your to-do list”.

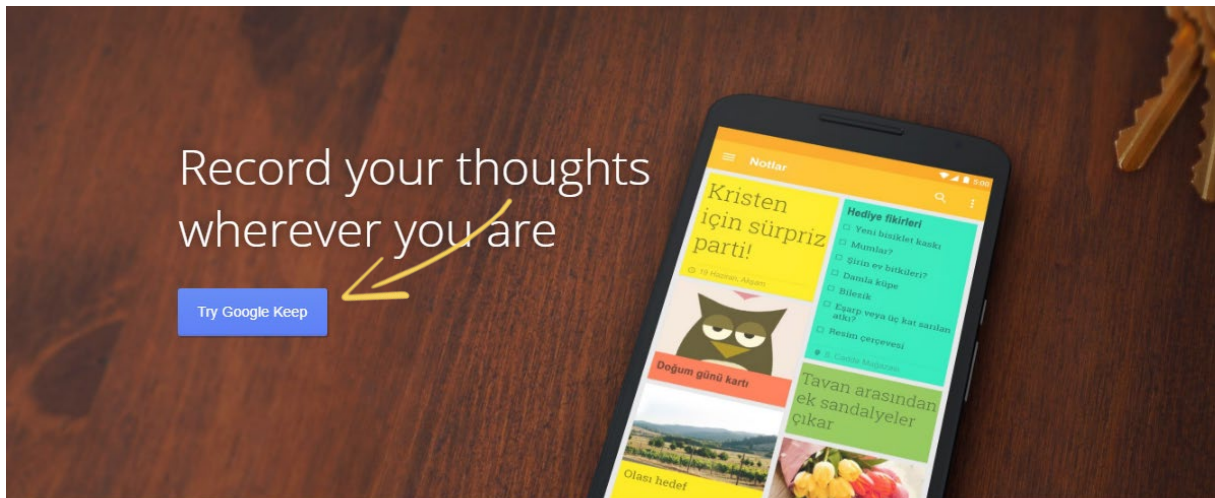

6.3.2. OneNote

Why using this tool – benefits

Microsoft's OneNote is actually a digital notepad accessible via the Internet. Designed to gather information from other programs or from the Internet, along with those written by the user, it has an extremely flexible structure, which allows great freedom of work. The data are contained in notebooks, which are divided into tabs, in turn divided into pages. Each of these parts is connected with the others in an information network and can be copied or moved from one notebook to another with a single click.

Furthermore, OneNote has been specifically programmed for the use with mobile devices (tablet and smartphone) and incorporates many digital ink features (absent in the web version), leveraging the Windows-integrated write recognition technology, which allows you to convert handwritten notes into editable text.

By installing an add-on, available for free, the program also allows you to enter and calculate mathematical equations.

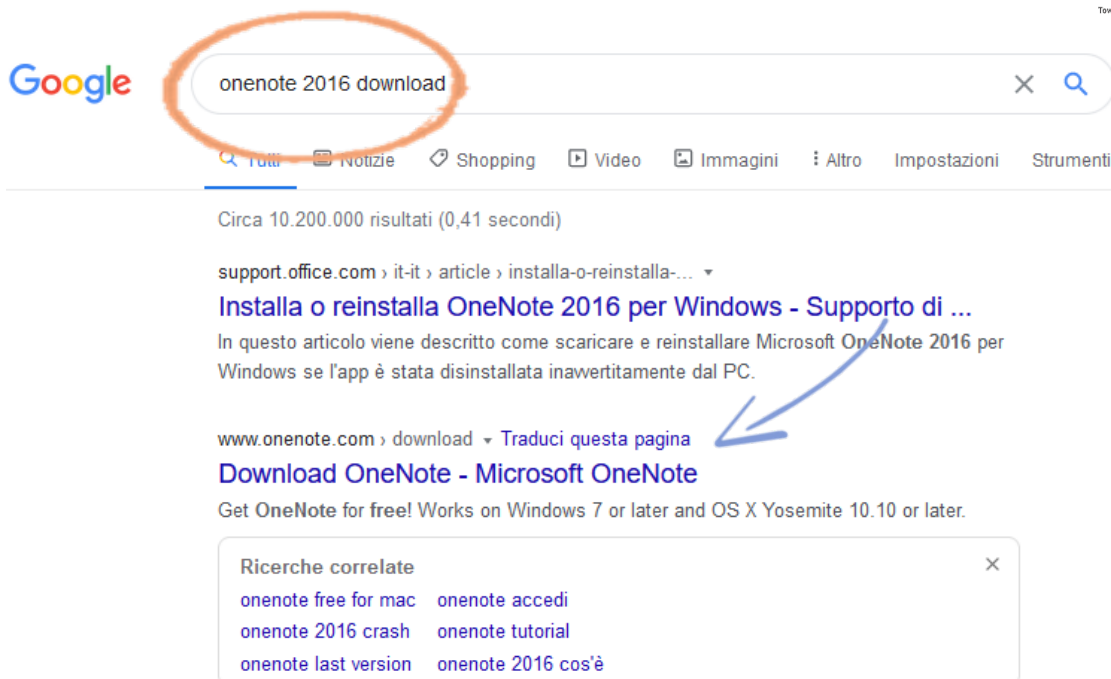
OneNote installs in your pc a dedicated printer (listed as "Send to OneNote"), suitable for clippings of various displayed objects.

Written instructions

Microsoft OneNote is an online note management program produced by Microsoft and distributed for free under commercial license. It is part of the Microsoft Office personal productivity package, and is available for Windows, macOS, iOS and Android operating systems. In 2016 Microsoft included OneNote in the Windows 10 suite, so the program is automatically available for all those who use this operating system. People using different operating system and/or without Microsoft Office package can anyway download for free the last separate version, published and available as OneNote 2016 (<https://www.onenote.com/download>).

As there are several different ways to obtain OneNote, according to your operating system and installed software, we are introducing here the easiest solution available for anyone, that's to say downloading OneNote 2016.

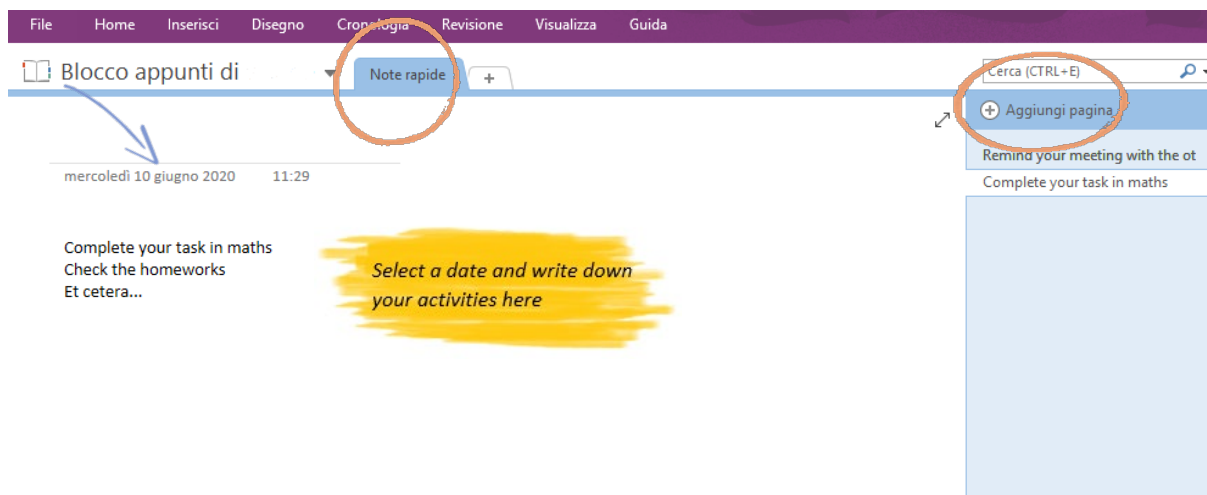
1. Open your browser and ask your search engine to download OneNote 2016:



2. A dialogue page will appear in front of you, and it should be in your Country language. If it shouldn't happen, or if you prefer to use a different language, you can change it clicking on the button in the bottom left corner. Once chosen the language, click on **Download**.

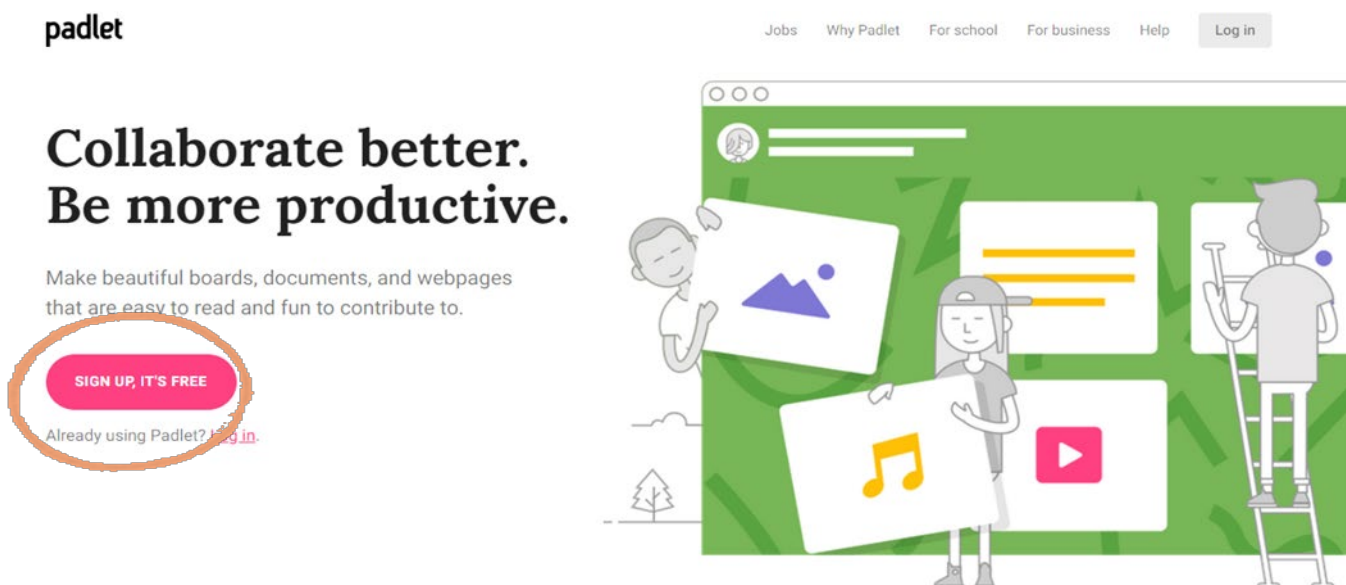
6.3.3. Padlet


Why using this tool – benefits

This is an internet tool that allows teachers and students to collect online information and upload them on Padlet’s digital board with just Drag & Drop. Videos, texts, hyperlinks, images etc can be added to Padlet’s digital board and can be organised like on a traditional class board, that used to be full of announcements and notes. Students can upload files, they have created, with activities or assignments and this can be shared with many other students; This feature is so useful, since it promotes team spirit and working together on projects even on the same time. Social media can also be integrated with these boards, blogs and if you feel confident enough on your IT skills, you can even transform this into a QR code. Padlet also protects privacy settings, so that sharing can be manageable by creators and other users.

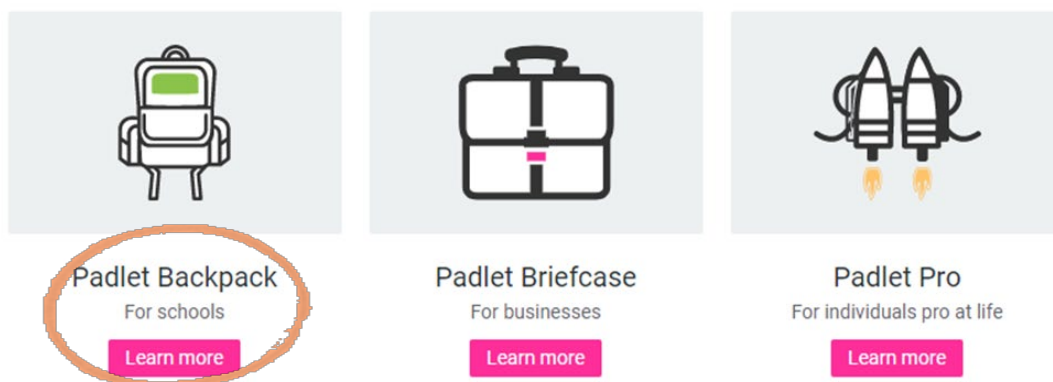

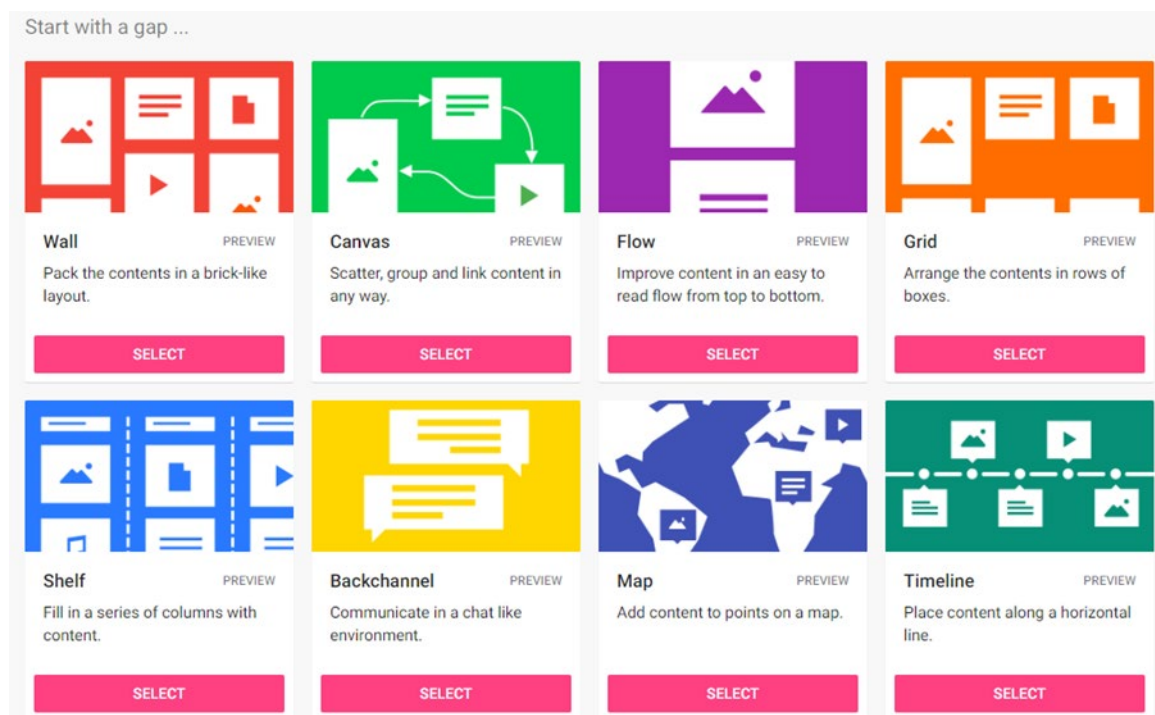

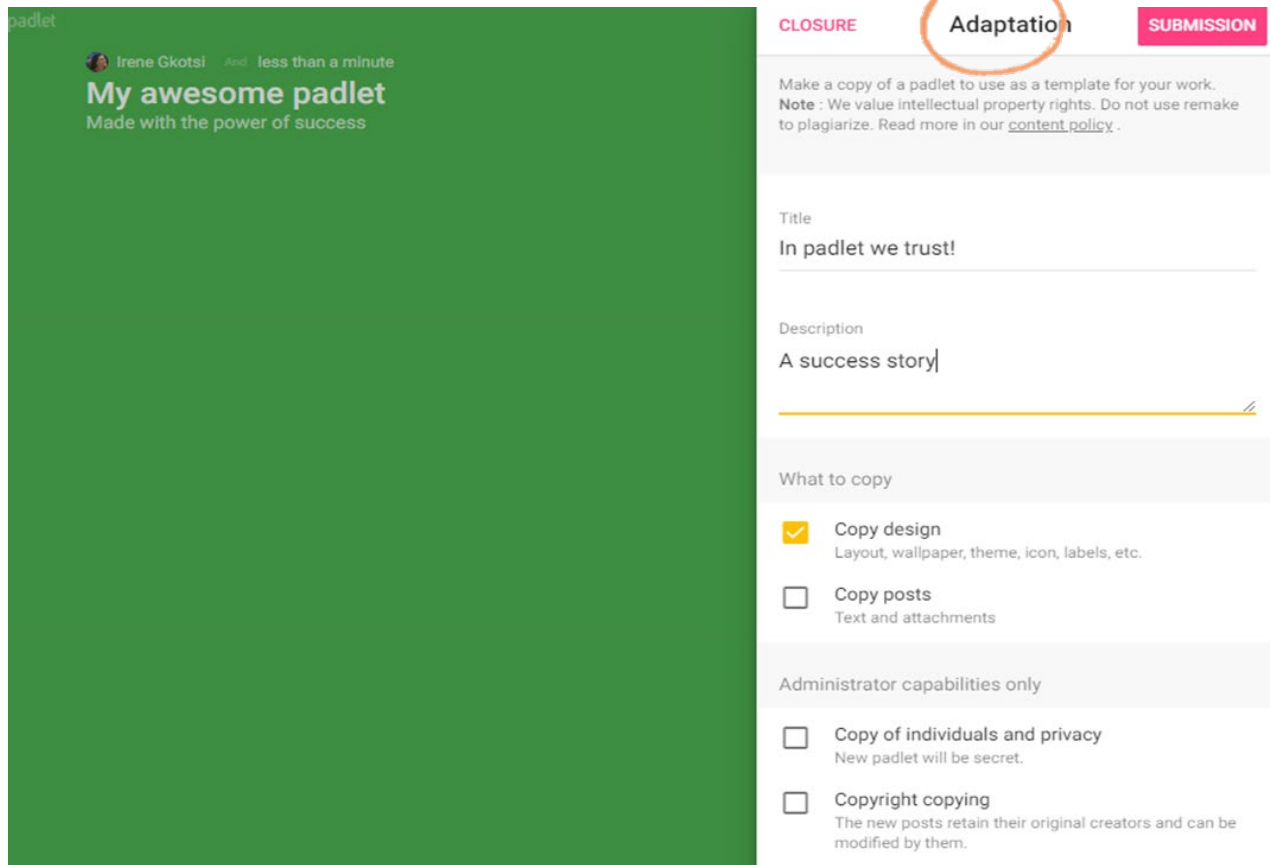

You can experiment a bit and find out which board is the most appropriate to your case. **Wall** and **Canvas** are the most common boards (Canvas is mostly about creating causal links between ideas, projects etc) **Flow** is for presenting content in a vertical way.

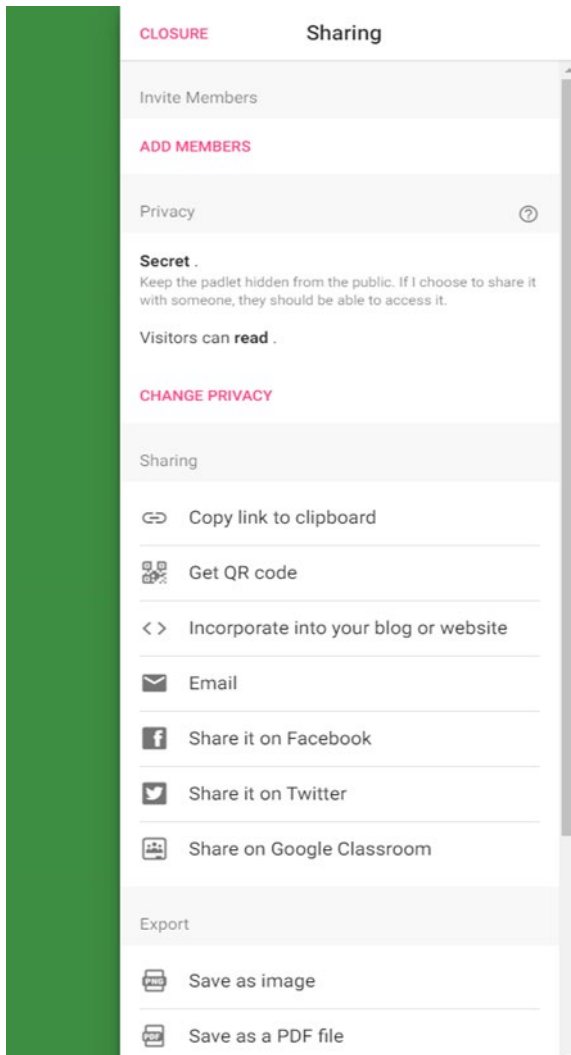
Grid supports row format, which works pretty well with some students and it is more or less the same with **Shelf**. **Backchannel** is like a chat room, where you can brainstorm and exchange ideas. **Map** fits perfect for international collaboration or geography course, while **Timeline** is best for road mapping and keeping schedule for your tasks.

Let's randomly choose **Canvas** and go to Adaptation:



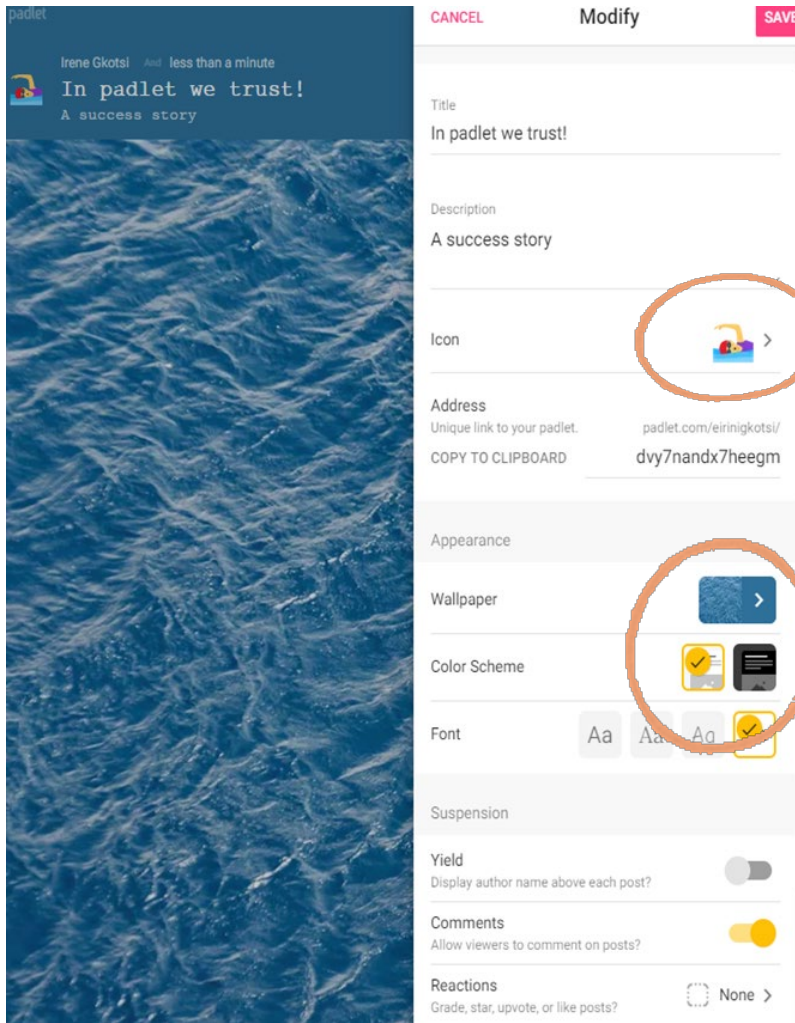

6.3.4. Plickers

Why using this tool – benefits

Plickers is an interesting app that allows you to carry out tests, quiz and other surveys and collect data in real time, without any need for students to use a device. The teacher uses a smartphone or tablet connected to the internet and creates a digital class. The teacher then distributes to the learners a series of so-called cards that contain special codes.

The teacher asks a question to the class and uses his smartphone or tablet to collect the answers of any student, scanning the codes on the cards. The App will record all the answers, that will be immediately reworked and made available to the teacher himself. The results will appear, therefore, in real time on the smartphone or tablet of the teacher or displayed on the interactive dashboard.

Plickers is a tool that integrates very well with any type of teaching. It makes the lessons more engaging and interactive and thanks to the strong visual potential allows a particularly effective and shared learning.

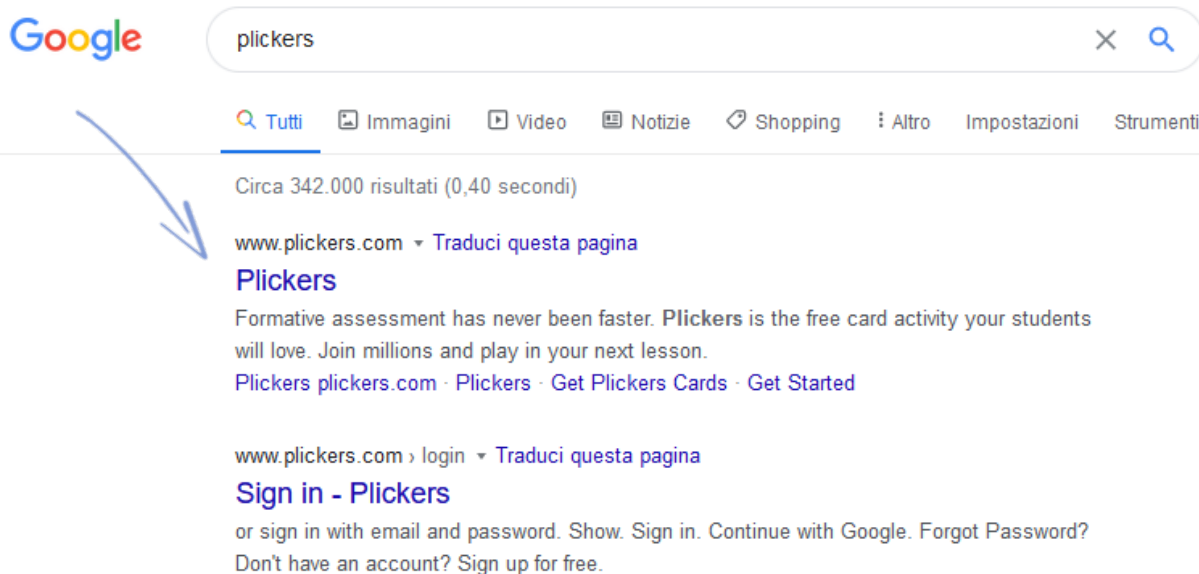
Like many other tools, Plickers is available for free. Teachers who like to use enhanced add-ons and special functionalities can make use of the professional version, paying a monthly or annual subscription, but the basic version offers all what you normally need for your educational purposes.

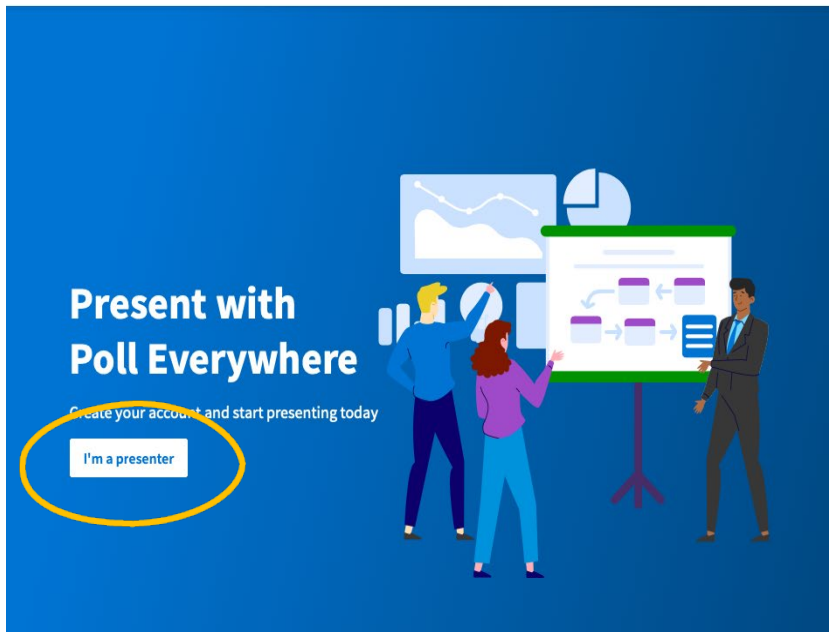
Why using this tool – benefits

Poll Everywhere is an online platform that allows teachers to create online surveys and receive direct responses, making it a useful tool to interact with students. They will have the opportunity to answer questions posed or discuss a topic proposed from any electronic device (mobile, tablets and computers), without the need to create an account, so it only needs internet connection. They can even participate anonymously! This eliminates the typical pressure of online exams or tests and encourages their participation without fear of making mistakes. It is therefore not useful for evaluating pupils, but it is an attractive means of engaging pupils in educational materials. However, the teacher does have to create an account to design the survey, which he can then share with his students through a link. One of the advantages of Poll Everywhere is that it allows you to create different types of surveys, such as: multiple choice questions, simple answers, open debates, etc. It is an agile and interactive tool that can be used for free. However, some users point to the number of limited responses as one of their disadvantages, since if the group is too large this tool may not be enough.

6.4. Game-based learning tools

A very engaging family of interactive tools are those comprising quizzical activities for quick formative assessment in any subject. With a couple of suggested tools, TCC VET aims at accompanying teachers while busy at stimulating the logical skills of their students, including problem solving, cooperative learning, ecc.

6.4.1. Kahoot!

Why using this tool – benefits

Kahoot! is an online game-based learning platform that transforms the learning procedure into a fun and enjoyable experience. It can support teachers in creating their own quiz (that are named Kahoot!) fast and easily and get the answers the next minute. Kahoot! can be used in the classroom for revision purposes or for the reflection of students on a course. Additionally, at the beginning of a training for ice-breaking, boosting the team spirit or in order to catch up with what has been taught so far. It can also be used for fun as a trivial game between students since it is really easy to be created.

Its basic version is for free, which means you can create an account and immediately have access to many templates and create your own portfolio. The basic disadvantage of this version is that you can engage only 10 people per quiz unless you want to address to teams instead of individual players. The rest of the versions available are a paid service, especially if you want to create a presentation. The platform's asset is fast engagement and flexibility, the fact that it can be used in laptops, tablets and smartphones and at the same time, it can be adopted to many languages and can be used for many different courses.

6.4.3. Quizizz

Why using this tool – benefits

Quizizz is an online tool designed to conduct student formative assessments in a fun and engaging way for students of all ages.

This tool differs from many other platforms oriented to learning by quiz because it is totally free of charge. It works on any device: web browser, iOS, Android and Chrome apps.

You can access hundreds of ready-made learning quiz or create your own. Join as a teacher, pick a quiz, and use the code for a virtual room to give to your students.

When you sign in and start browsing the website, you will easily discover a search page where for each subject of teaching you can find the tests already made by other teachers, and all of them are available, printable, duplicable and therefore modifiable.

Teachers have multiple options to customize their quiz session to toggle the level of competition, speed, and other factors. Quizizz is anyway student-paced: questions appear on each student's screen, so they can answer questions at their own pace, and review their answers at the end.

Quizizz is ever mindful of the importance of distance learning. In 2020, kitchen tables and sofas may have replaced classroom desks and cubicles, but that hasn't stopped student engagement: whether playing live or asynchronously, students always see questions on their own devices and they can give answers from wherever they are, keeping on learning!





- Once completed the registration process, you will land in your dashboard, that is very easy to be used: in the centre of the page you can select a subject to teach, while the column on the left allows you to create your new quiz, to find quiz already available, to create your classes and so on. Let's go to see step-by-step how you can positively engage your students.

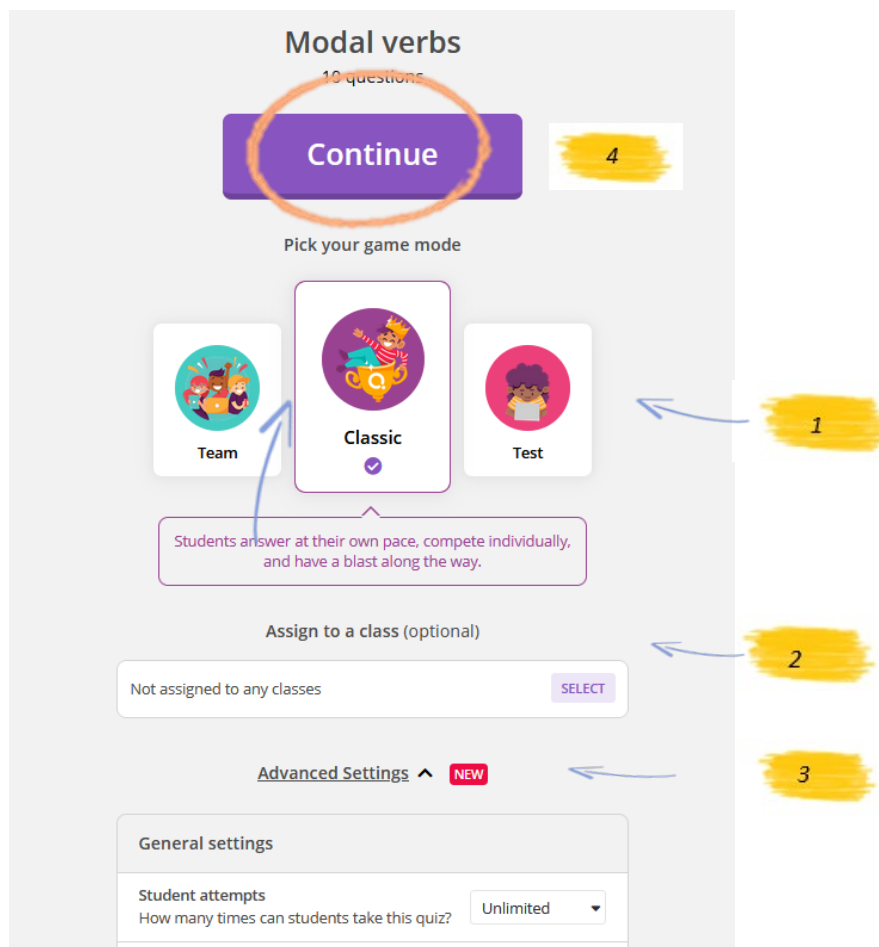

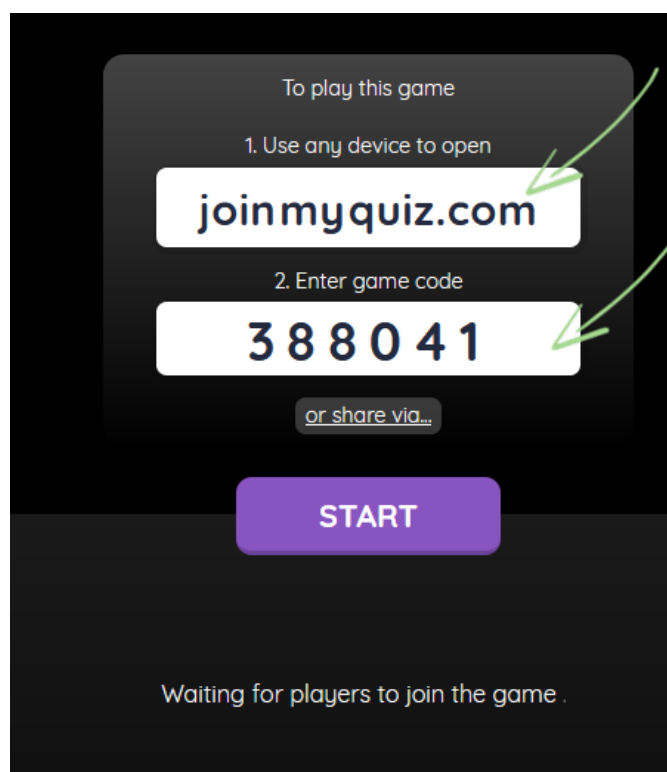


8. Let's say you want to **play live** in the classroom: click on the relevant button and land in the following page:



Here you can decide which kind of game your students will play: in team, classic version or test activity to be assessed. You will then assign the quiz to a class, creating it if you didn't do before, and provide the advanced settings. At the end, everything will be ready, and you can click on **Continue**.

9. Now it's time to involve your class: your device will display the following screen, showing the website your students have to connect to and the relevant game code they have to digit on their devices. While they link, on your screen you will be able to check when all of them are ready to **Start**.



10. The students will visualize the questions on their devices and they will give the answers. At the end of the game you can check the answers and have an assessment. You can also click on **Reports** in your dashboard (left column) to have a statistic feed-back including all your quiz.
